





## Future Scope of BPO


Over the next ten years, employment of orthotists and prosthetists is expected to rise by 20 percent, far faster than the average for all occupations.\* With the growing population, orthotists and prosthetists will be needed because both diabetes and fatal accidents, two leading causes of loss of limbs, are more prevalent among the population.



Upon completion of the Bachelor's degree in Prosthetics and Orthotics, young students have the liberty of either expanding the spectrum of the course to profession or pursuing the predetermined employment.


